3. Superintendent and maintenance report:

Jim expressed frustration that the driving range is not done. Skip explained where the project stands. We are waiting on electricity and for the mats to be placed. Jim inquired about the path project and if the paths were done correctly. Skip- Brightview is correcting the issues with the cart paths.

- Pins have all been replaced with new ones. We now have red, white, and blue flags.

- Golf cart path repair is almost complete. 2 areas still need to be completed.
